Planting:

325m length of hedgerow Wildflower meadow and the reintroduction of native trees at the Coppice Lane Depot.


Upgrades to the ground drainage system and water courses.

3 Heat Air pump systems installed into buildings to avoid using conventional fossil fuel systems





Integration of new microsoft software to enable remote working. The use of TEAMS to create a more efficient, streamlined office, cutting down the use of paper.



Repairs and upgrades to the light and sound equipment with more integration of LED's. Recycled any unwanted or broken equipment.

Upgraded and streamlined the transport fleet reduced the number of our vehicles on the roads reducing carbon emissions

Rethought tour routes for 2021,
By rerouting a total of 1023 miles saved across the same number of venues.
Just this action alone has reduced CO₂ emission, less diesel used and saved £8600 in fuel costs

Revisited performers touring schedules extending visas, reducing the number of flights needed.

An initial saving of 11 Long Haul flights which would have caused 67,953lbs or 30.8 tonnes of CO₂ emissions which would need a total of 794 trees to be planted to offset this.
